# Pupil Premium

---

The pupil premium is an allocation of additional funding provided to schools to support specific groups of children who are vulnerable to possible underachievement. These include pupils who are entitled to free school meals, those looked after by the local authority and the children of armed service personnel.

All schools are required to report on the amount of funding received and how this is being used.

### **2014/2015**

Wood End's Pupil Premium in 2014/2015 was £28,350. All the money was for children entitled for free school meals.

We continued with better readers, reading recovery, extra maths support, speech and language, drawing and talking, emotional support and support for EAL children.

We have bought in to the Achievement for all scheme for the year.

In addition delivered Read write inc 1-1 tuition and talk boost for children who need to catch up with their speaking and listening and literacy.

### **IMPACT (2014–15)**

31 Pupil Premium children

#### Foundation

82% achieved a good level of development.

#### Year 1

All pupil premium children passed the end of year 1 Phonics test.

Reading – APS 13.8 Above average

Writing – APS 10.7 Average

Maths – APS 10.6 Average

#### Year 2

Pupil premium group end of year results

Reading – APS 17.33 Average

Writing – APS 13.67 Below Average

### **2015-2016**

The allocation is £40,920

We will continue with Better Readers, Talk Boost, 1-1 Read Write Inc support, drawing and talking, emotional support, EAL support and small Read, Write Inc teaching groups. In addition we have employed a Teaching Assistant to provide each class with an afternoon of Forest Schools. This will enable children to learn through play and the outdoor curriculum.
